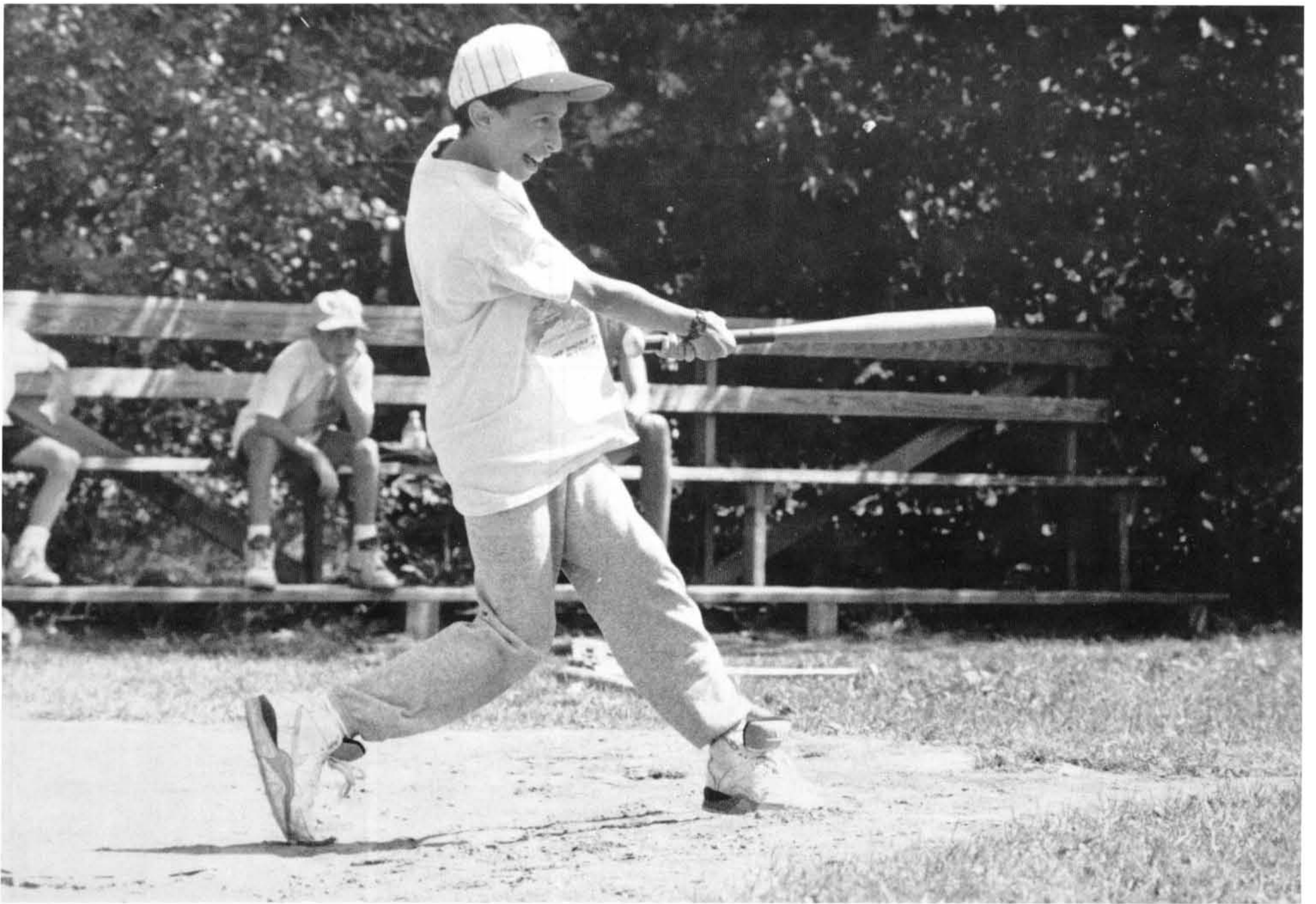


A Bird's Eye View of the Beautiful Berkshires

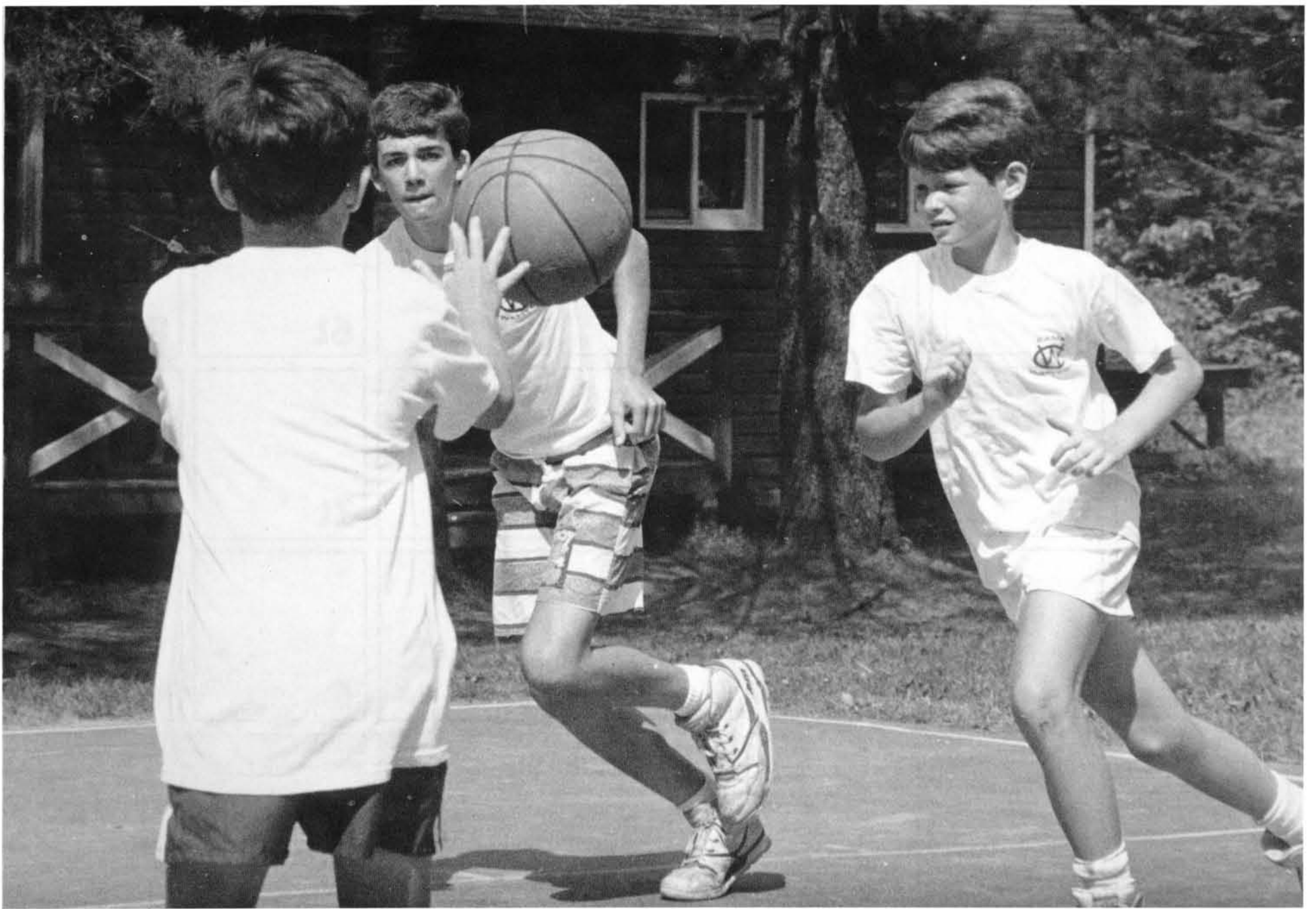


Spraying up a Wall of Water on a Slalom Ski
